-Advantages :-

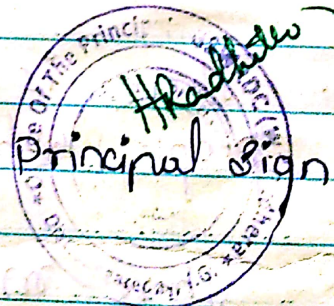
1. Violent video games help an individual become more aware of their environment.

-Advantages :-

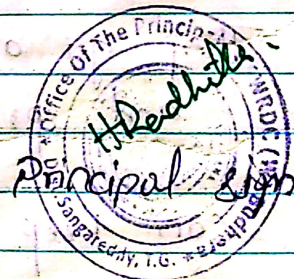
1. They get opportunity to socialise healthily and helps the students know and adapt to community living

1) Gender-based violence has a very heavy economic cost. It makes people underachieve at work and in education, and it negatively affects their productivity.

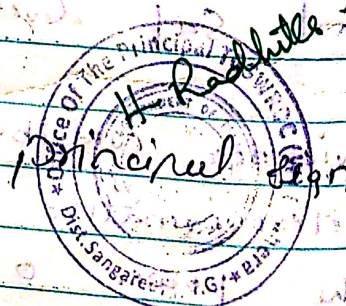
2) This makes denouncing violence in the family difficult.

Advantages of public schools :-

Affordability : For students who can not afford high fees, public schools offer education at a lower cost.

Inclusiveness : They provide education to students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds, including underprivileged students. They offer reserve seats for SC/ST students.

Support for basic needs : Government schools may provide meals, clothing and supplies to needy students.

Disadvantages of public schools:

Poor quality of education: The quality of education is often poor, with inadequate resources and outdated teaching methods.

Language barrier: classes may not be taught in English, leaving students unprepared for careers that require English language skills.

Inadequate infrastructure: Many public schools lack adequate facilities and infrastructure, hindering effective learning.

Limited focus on holistic development: Due to resource constraints, public schools may not emphasize discipline, hygiene and holistic developments.

Advantages of private schools:

English medium education:

Private schools often provide English medium education, preparing students for English based career opportunities.

Holistic development: private schools concentrate on holistic education, which includes academics, character building, discipline and sanitation.

Extracurricular opportunities: Promoting teamwork and overall skill development, they offer a wide range of extracurricular activities and sports.

Adequate infrastructure: private schools tend to have better infrastructure and facilities, helping students pursue their career goals.

Disadvantages of private schools:

High cost: private schools tend to be expensive, limiting access to students from low income families.

In summary, public schools offer affordability and inclusiveness, but may lack quality education and infrastructure, private schools offer better resources, English medium education and comprehensive development, but at a higher cost.
